- We like to challenge the status quo and consistently improve our ways of working and introducing the latest in technology offerings to deliver the best value and experience for our customers.

What are the Benefits?

- No more wait times.
- Built in smart logic and automation allows you to generate/visualize a draft Bank Guarantees in Standard Format, instantaneously.
- Why wait for ANZ to generate a Draft for you, when you can provide the same details and generate the Draft by yourself, right there and then!
- Visualize/Amend drafts immediately and expedite discussions with Beneficiaries, change details in the Request Form to refresh Draft details on-demand, anytime!
- ANZ will only need to be engaged when details have been finalized and you are ready to proceed with issuance of the Bank Guarantee.

How to use the Form in 4 easy steps

Step Description

Access the Form

Save the Form (PDF File)

Click the link for 'ANZ Bank Guarantee Request Form' on the webpage, which downloads a copy of the file or prompts user to save a copy on a Local drive location. Provide appropriate file name and save as appropriate.

Navigate to the Local drive location and open the file using 'Adobe PDF Reader' or higher versions.

Finalise Guarantee details

Follow the instructions and prompts to fill details relevant to your request, select "Preview Draft" to finalise and Print the Bank Guarantee Draft.

**Not ready to finalise it? Go to FILE->SAVE AS on your device, so you don't lose details entered.

Print, Sign and Submit

Once Draft details have been agreed to, between all parties, click "Provide Details for Issuance", complete the additional details, and print by selecting "Submit for Issuance".

The forms needs to be signed by Authorised Signatory (if required) and then submit them to ANZ, for Final issuance, via the chosen method/channel (Email or Transactive Trade).

Need Help?

The form requires various fields to be updated manually and most fields have built in validation rules to ensure right input is provided to ensure ANZ receives full instructions to the request. Throughout the form, upon incorrect updates, users are prompted with instructions around the format of input and fields also display pop-up messages to provide instructions where relevant. For example, the ABN/ACN and Amount fields only accept a "Numeric" value, mandatory fields cannot be left blank, etc.

In addition, this Reference Guide will provide a step-by-step guide on pre-populating the form and describe each field. Alternatively, you can also contact the <u>Trade Guarantees Team</u> for additional help.



This selection defines the purpose of the request.




Looking for something else?

The Bank Guarantee request form allows user to self-serve a Draft Bank Guarantee in "Standard Format & Wording". For any bespoke/unique/non-standard issuance clauses/scenarios, please contact <u>Trade</u> <u>Guarantees Team</u>.


Branch Selection

This field lets you choose the place of Issuance and drives subsequent standard undertaking clause for "Place of Presentation".

For example: If the applicant or the beneficiary prefers to get the issuance from Sydney, simply choose Sydney from the dropdown and proceed further with the form.



Important Information:



- After the Branch selection, user will get a pop-up message stating the chosen location will be considered for place of presentation for a written Demand or Notice.
- This however does not limit the customer from presenting any demands or notices in other ANZ branches. ANZ will continue to honour all demands or notices presented in any of ANZs branches across Australia as they do today.


Party Type Selection

Select the appropriate party type based on whether the borrower & applicant are same or different parties.

Note: This form is dynamic and additional fields will be presented depending on the selections you make.

SAME: Both Borrower & Applicant are the same parties





Beneficiary Type Selection

Beneficiary type allows for Two options: Individual or Company or Trustee





Multiple Beneficiary Details

- The form also amends the Draft accordingly based on number of Beneficiary Parties added to change the "Beneficiary Address" and various standard clauses recognizing Single or Multiple Beneficiary details provided.
- The form allows for a maximum of 10 Beneficiary Parties to the same Bank Guarantee on the form.
 - o Similar information is to be provided for each Beneficiary.




Preview Draft

When all the mandatory fields are filled, User can then click "Preview Draft", so the form generates an automated draft based on all the information provided.

If any of the mandatory fields are left blank or have not filled, the user is prompted with an error message requesting them to complete relevant field that was missed.



When all mandatory fields are filled, click on "Preview Draft", a preview message comes up before moving to the Draft generated.



Additional Details for Issuance



Frequently Asked Questions (FAQS)

- Why do we have a new application form?
 - At ANZ, we aim to do things better and simple, so we enhance our customer's banking experience. The application form has been rebuilt for a smoother end to end process with the introduction of new features and enhanced capabilities.
- Can I edit the Bank Guarantee application form to include specific clauses that I require?
 - Any changes to the standard clauses of a Bank Guarantee need to be approved by ANZ and are considered "Non-Standard Guarantees" which will require a separate application process. Please contact you ANZ representative for further information.
- Do I need to complete the Bank Guarantee application form if I'm a Transactive Portal enabled customer?
 - We are happy to receive your Bank Guarantee requests via Portal, our Digital platform.
 - You can utilise this new application form to populate details & visualise the draft. When happy with the final draft, you can submit a request from portal by replicating the same details in portal or updating mandatory fields followed by attaching the completed for reference.
 - For requests submitted via portal, ANZ will continue to service your requests as per the existing process.
- What are the new features & enhanced capabilities?
 - Guarantee requests can now be printed in a draft format, which allows the Applicant and Beneficiary to visualise, clarify and confirm the wording of the Bank Guarantee, prior to Final issuance from ANZ.
 - New capabilities/features
 - The ability to input up to 10 Beneficiary's in the tool.
 - This tool can also be used to replace existing issuance by choosing the appropriate issue type.
 - Pop up boxes with instructions on what is required for each field, will make it a one stop shop for instructions.
 - Warnings for invalid input, to avoid applications being returned by ANZ for more information.
- Will I have to pay any fees to use the new self-serve application form?
 - The new form is just an enhanced tool for customers to easily self-serve & provide all required information to ANZ in one-go, ready for Issuance, there is no extra fee involved.
