Date	Holiday
1 January	New Year's Day
26 January	Australia Day
3 April	Good Friday
6 April	Easter Monday
25 April	ANZAC Day
25 December	Christmas Day
26 December	Boxing Day
28 December	Boxing Day Observed

All banks are closed on National public holidays and, accordingly, no payments are processed.

Furthermore, National public holidays are also classified as non-business days in terms of AUD/ Foreign currency trades and therefore are not good value dates upon which to settle Australian dollar foreign exchange transactions.

New South Wales

Date	Holiday
8 June	King's Birthday holiday (All States and Territories except Western Australia and Queensland)
3 August	Bank Holiday (NSW Only)
5 October	Labour Day (Australian Capital Territory, New South Wales, South Australia)

In addition, the three NSW public holidays listed are also classified as non-business days in terms of AUD/ foreign currency trades. In contrast to National public holidays, payments will still be able to be processed but there will be no RITS Evening Settlement Session.
