## CHANGES TO ANZ FEES AND CHARGES

We're making changes to some of our fees and charges, effective 1 April 2022. We've summarised the changes below.

In the past we've charged an Electronic transaction fee that consisted of EFTPOS fees, Bill Payment fees, Internet Banking transfer fees and ATM withdrawal fees. After 1 April 2022 EFTPOS transactions, Bill Payments and Internet Banking transfers will be free and ATM withdrawal fees will be charged at the time of transaction as set out below.
