ANZ to operate on Saturdays in Ho Chi Minh City

ANZ Vietnam is now opening three of its full service branches in Ho Chi Minh City (HCMC) on Saturdays to bring greater flexibility, access and convenience to customers. ANZ was amongst the first foreign banks in Vietnam to open on Saturdays in Hanoi since June 2010 and is now the only foreign bank to open on Saturdays in HCMC.
