ANZ Vietnam opens Binh Duong representative office

ANZ Vietnam today announced the official opening of its representative office in Binh Duong, having received its final approvals from the State Bank of Vietnam.

ANZ Vietnam CEO Tareq Muhmood said: "The new representative office confirms our commitment to the local market and reinforces our bank's strategic focus on supporting our customers, particularly those active in the Binh Duong region such as food & beverage processing, animal feed, textiles, garment and leather production, packaging, and furniture."

"With the establishment of the Binh Duong representative office, we will be able to get closer to our customers and contribute to the economic development of the region. The recent delivery of MoneyMinded – an ANZ financial education program – to disadvantaged youth at the Binh Duong Vocational Training Center by ANZ staff is an example of our commitment to growing sustainably in this region," Mr Muhmood said.

ANZ was among the first international banks to operate in Vietnam, establishing its first office in 1993 in the form of foreign bank branch. In 2008, ANZ was approved by the State Bank of Vietnam to establish ANZ Bank (Vietnam) Limited. Under this new entity, ANZ has expanded its network by opening additional outlets across Vietnam. ANZ has 11 branches and transaction points in Vietnam offering a full range of services including retail banking, commercial banking for small, medium and emerging businesses, as well as institutional banking.
